It has come to our attention that some of our families, more specifically the parents of students who have recently taken the PSAT, have received phone calls from individuals claiming to be from The College Board. The representative tells parents that his/her child checked off a box on the scantron, and by providing your credit card information, their company will send the requested test preparation materials.

We're alerting you to this because this is a known telemarketing SCAM. <u>**Do not**</u> provide your credit card information!

The College Board does not make unsolicited phone calls to students or families requesting this type of information.
