Our facilities at Austin High School are top-notch and include three gyms, recently refurbished science facilities, and our newly expanded annex with spacious suites for band, orchestra, and choir.

We offer both MTSS (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support) and BARR (Building Assets, Reducing Risks), and we are working to implement both the Packer Profile and Packer Pathways for all learners!

AHS students who participated in our concurrent college enrollment offerings saved an average of $\$ 2,092$ in college costs while those who participated in PSEO saved an average of $\$ 4,785$ !

We partner with the community for many programs, including:

- Creating Entrepreneurial Opportunities (CEO), where students learn from local business leaders as they create their own businesses,
- The Hormel Foundation Austin Assurance Scholarship, which offers qualifying Austin graduates two years tuition-free at Riverland Community College,
